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### Eligibility:

Our Junior Golf Program is open to all children between the ages of 6 and 18. Children and grandchildren of Golf, Social, and Dining Members, as well as guests of Kenosha Country Club are welcome.

Times for Junior Golf Lessons and Play are as follows:

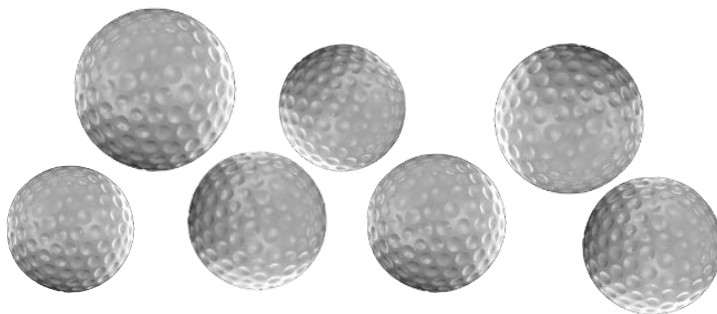

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### General Information

After each lesson, all Juniors immediately go to play golf. This gives them an opportunity to put into practice what they have just learned.

The Juniors are grouped and the 1, 2, and 3-Holers are assigned a parent (or caddie) to keep score. This scorer also has the important job of monitoring the Juniors for safe habits, while encouraging good sportsmanship.



## New to the Program

Parents of all Juniors who have not participated in a Junior Golf program before should call our PGA Professional, Eric Malone, if there are any questions regarding the program or equipment.

There are several key factors used in determining how many holes a Junior Golfer should play.

The most important is *how* they play when entering the program, as each division has an acceptable high and low score.

Age is a factor as well, as is the parents wishes, for the level of competitiveness for each Junior.

Eric will blend each of these factors together to create a starting point.

Once a Junior Golfer starts the program, there may still be some shifting from one division to another.

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### Clubs

New clubs are available for purchase. This year there is a wonderful selection of junior irons, woods and bags from Cobra and TaylorMade. Make use of the Mill River Plan and shop early while the selection is good.
