This year, Junior Golf will begin on **Tuesday**, June 16<sup>th</sup> running **Tuesday's** through August 4<sup>th</sup>. The Junior Tournament will be held July 21<sup>st</sup>, July 28<sup>th</sup>, and August 4<sup>th</sup>. The two best of the three scores will determine the tournament winner.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Children and grandchildren of Golf, Social and Dining Members between the ages of 6 and 18. Due to COVID-19, the 2020 Junior Golf Program is only open to children and grandchildren of Kenosha Country Club members. Guests will not be able to participate.

**NEW TO PROGRAM:** All juniors who have not participated in Junior Golf before should call Eric Malone, if they have any questions about their equipment.

There are several factors that help determine how many holes a junior should play. The most important is how they play. There is an acceptable high and low score for each division. Age is a factor, as are the parent's wishes for the level of competitiveness. Eric will try to blend all of these together for a starting point. Once Junior Golf starts there still may be some shifting from one division to another.

**FEES:** Fees listed below include: lessons, golf, tournaments and fun. Golf, Social, and Dining Members will have Junior Golf Fees charged to their KCC account.

Golf & Social Members - \$140.00

Dining Members - \$160.00

**CLUBS:** New clubs are available for purchase. This year there is a wonderful selection of junior irons, woods and bags from Cobra and Taylor Made. Make use of the Mill River Plan and shop early while the selection is good.

**PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY:** Parents play an important part in Junior Golf in that they are expected to provide safety and keep score for the juniors while they are on the golf course. With that, parents of 1, 2, or 3 holers are expected to walk with and keep score for their children a minimum of three times for each child.

Parents will not be allowed to score for their own children during the 3 tournament weeks. Play takes place immediately following the golf lesson. If for any reason a parent cannot be present, they have the option of arranging for another person to do the scoring. Caddies will not be available for the 2020 Junior Golf Season.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** After each golf lesson, all juniors go immediately to play golf. This gives them a chance to put into practice what they have been taught. The juniors are grouped and the 1, 2, and 3 holers are assigned a parent to keep score. The scorer also has the important job of practicing safety habits and encouraging good sportsmanship.

**GENERAL RULES**

1. While it may look like a big park to the juniors, scorers must hold down loud boisterous activity. We want to teach them at an early age how to act on their golf course.
2. It works best not to have parents score for their children during the three week tournament. We will try to have both parent and child finish as close together as possible.
3. The maximum swings allowed in front of water hazard #2 is 2. After 2 swings from in front of the water, the player is allowed to pick up the ball and place it on the other side of the water, one stroke penalty (for 1, 2 & 3 holers only).
4. The maximum strokes allowed from a sand bunker is 3. After 3 swings from the sand, the player is allowed to pick up the ball and place it on the grass no nearer the hole with no penalty stroke added (again, for 1, 2 & 3 holers only). Remind the juniors to rake the bunker.
5. All divots must be replaced.
6. No temper displays will be tolerated.
7. All putting areas are sacred. Juniors must not run or put bags on the greens.
8. No practice swings are allowed. This makes it easier for the scorer. (1, 2, 3 Holers Only)
9. After the allotted number of holes has been played, each scorer must turn in the scorecard at the Golf Shop. These scores are important to us. They let us know who may need extra help.
10. All juniors and spectators must follow the dress code while on the golf course. This includes our no denim policy.
